WEBSITE COOKIE CLARIFICATION TEXT

As ED ZEMİN TEKNOLOJİLERİ A.Ş. (Data Controller), we use various cookie data files to ensure our users can safely and fully benefit from our internet (web) services, to store users' customised preferences in the application interface and improve user experience, to compile statistical information, and to protect the privacy of our visitors.

Cookies help our website or mobile platforms remember your preferences and allow you to access this information the next time you visit the same site (for example, the information you enter when logging in to our website, language, location and other preferences). This way, you do not need to re-enter this information when you visit our website or mobile applications.

Cookies only contain information about the User's browsing history on the internet and do not collect any information about files stored on the computer and/or mobile device. Cookies can only be read by the site that created them. The site also determines how long a cookie is stored.

The purpose of this Cookie Clarification Text is to inform you about the types of cookies we use and their purposes, the legal basis and your rights regarding the processing of personal data obtained automatically through cookies placed on your device on our website.

Types of Cookies

By Purpose

- **Mandatory Cookies:** Cookies required for the operation of the website by enabling its basic functions.
- **Performance Cookies:** Cookies that collect information about users' use of and preferences regarding the website anonymously, thereby enabling improvement of the website's performance.
- **Functional Cookies:** Cookies that enable the website to offer personalised services such as language and region by remembering users' preferences in future visits based on their past use of the website.
- **Advertising Cookies:** Cookies used to track users' online activities, identify personal areas of interest and display targeted advertisements based on those interests/needs.

By Duration

- **Session Cookies (Temporary Cookies):** Cookies used to ensure session continuity that are deleted when the user closes their internet browser.
- **Persistent Cookies:** Cookies that transmit processed data to the server each time the user visits the website, are not deleted when the browser is closed, and delete themselves after a certain period.

First-Party and Third-Party Cookies

- First-party cookies are placed directly by the website the user is visiting.
- Third-party cookies are placed by a third party different from the website the user is visiting.

You can control your cookie preferences on our website and grant/withdraw your permissions through the cookie settings. Mandatory cookies are used on our website for the site to function and generate data that does not constitute personal data. You must use the cookie settings for explanations regarding other types of cookies and management of your permissions for those cookies. We request your consent for cookies other than mandatory cookies.

Additionally, to change your preferences regarding the use of cookies or to block or delete cookies, it is sufficient to change your internet browser settings. Many browsers offer you the option to accept or decline cookies, accept only certain types of cookies, or be notified by the browser when a website requests to store a cookie on your device. It is also possible to delete cookies previously saved in your browser. Cookie control or deletion procedures may vary depending on the browser you use.

However, disabling cookies in your browser may affect your user experience on our website. If persistent or session cookies are not used, you may continue to view our website with missing components and limited access capabilities. We recommend that you allow cookies to fully benefit from our website and application.

The Data Controller may process personal data collected through cookies based on the legal basis of "processing being mandatory for the legitimate interests of the Data Controller provided it does not infringe the fundamental rights and freedoms of the data subject" as specified in Article 5(2) of the Personal Data Protection Law No. 6698, or with the explicit consent of the data subject, subject to meeting the specified conditions (legal bases).

As the Data Controller, we may remove cookies used on our website and applications, or change their types or functions. Any updates made to this Clarification Text shall enter into force upon publication on our website and web applications.

Your Rights as a Data Subject

Pursuant to the Law, data subjects have the following rights:

- To learn whether personal data is being processed.
- To request information regarding personal data stated to be processed.
- To learn the processing purpose and whether data is used in accordance with its purpose.
- To request correction of incomplete or inaccurately processed data and to request that such operations be notified to third parties to whom personal data has been transferred, where applicable.
- To learn the third parties to whom personal data has been transferred domestically or abroad, where applicable.
- To request deletion or destruction of collected data and to request that such operations be notified to third parties to whom personal data has been transferred, where applicable.
- To claim compensation for damages that may arise due to unlawfully processed data.
- To object to the emergence of a result against the person themselves by analysing the processed data exclusively through automated systems.

You may submit your requests regarding these rights within the scope of the rights specified in Article 11 of the Law in writing, or by using a registered electronic mail (KEP) address, secure electronic signature, mobile signature or the electronic mail address previously notified to the Data Controller and registered in the Data Controller's system, or through a software or application developed for the purpose of application. You may also submit your requests to us through the Application Form available on the Data Controller's website. Your applications shall be assessed and concluded as soon as possible and within a maximum of 30 (thirty) days from the date of notification.

While no fee is charged for requests as a general rule, the Data Controller reserves the right to charge a fee in accordance with the fee schedule determined by the Personal Data Protection Board.
